- Mr. Köhn thanked the Board for the opportunity to be the new ED. He feels that there is a strong foundation in place at OSA and the school is ready to move forward.
- Building Update—water damage at the Fox. On Thursday, 2/9/17 the main campus experienced a sprinkler malfunction on the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor. Water damage to 5 -3<sup>rd</sup> floor classrooms, 5 -2<sup>nd</sup> floor classrooms, and the both 3<sup>rd</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> floor hallways in the immediate area. Conversations are on going with the insurance company.
- ED's 45 day Report ~ Looking at the 4 Pillars of the Strategic Plan
- I. An extensive survey was taken during auditions of the applicants to assist in identifying 'who our kids are'. We want to further engage Arts Organizations with OSA.
- II. Beginning discussions about colleges teaching courses at OSA or OSA students taking classes at colleges for advance credit.
