#### **Campus Readiness**

Lead by our Director of Facilities and Safety, Mr. Walter Harris, our campus supervisors, Mr. Secrease, Ms. Olden and Mr. Vance, have been working tirelessly to upgrade our facilities, meet health and safety guidelines and prepare classrooms to welcome back both students and teachers.



### Campus Return

We remain optimistic that the Covid situation in the Bay Area will continue to improve and are planning on a full return to campus for all arts and academic classes. This return is dependent on the current guidance that social distancing requirements in schools will be lifted. All updated city, county, and state health guidelines will be strictly adhered to and communicated with all families prior to the return on August 16th. We understand that vaccinations will likely not be available to our 10-11 year old students prior to our return and will be providing an opportunity for academic independent study for students not comfortable returning until fully vaccinated. We will share details with all families on August 2nd with up-to-date health and safety guidance and information regarding the independent study option.

#### **NEW FAMILY FAQS**

- · When does school start?
  - The first day is Monday, August 16th. School starts at 8:15. Middle school ends at 3:20, High School ends at 4:15.
- What supplies does my student need for the first week of school?
  - Pencils, pen, notebook, binders, water bottle and a positive attitude!
- · Where should my student go on the first day of school?
  - Students can go directly to their first period class, starting at 8:15. Schedules will be shared at orientation and available on Power School.
- How do I log into Power School to see student's progress, attendance and assignments?
  - New families will receive family login prior to the start of school. If you don't see it, by 8/16 email Ms. Brown at studentrecords@oakarts.org for login information and tutorial video.
- Is there a parent/family organization I can join?
  - Yes. Please contact aptboardosa@gmail.com the Alliance of Parents and Teachers (APT), a parent run group who will also provide login information for their communication platform, Konstella.
- Does OSA offer an after-school program?
  - Yes. OSA's after school program operates from 3:25 to 5:00 M/T/Th/F and 1:00 to 5:00 on Wednesdays. Students have a minimum day on Wednesdays to allow for staff professional development. Registration and cost information will be available in early August.
